As we move ever so quickly into the "end of days", there is much thinking and questioning as to where we actually are in time. The "end times" travail is definitely showing up in the weather, earthquakes, Tsunamis, extreme draught and rains, threats of worldwide economic collapse and major war fronts all around the world. The spirit of confusion and fear are heavily at work. Even the "worldly view point" exhibits much fear as you see it in the news, movies, books, and the fast rise in militant survivalist groups. People are becoming fearful and they should be for good reason.

Yahweh's Spirit is warning the world to prepare and get ready for what has been written in the Scriptures and the Renewed Covenant Writings as an extreme event that will shake the world to its very core. There has never been a time like it However, many modern day false teachings are coming from the pulpits and are placing people into a complacency by stating "don't worry for we are going to be raptured up when things start getting unbearable". These teachings are not true and are deceiving many.

When you study the Word from a Hebrew perspective, you naturally start collecting bits of Truth as they are unveiled. In my recent study, I came across a verse that tied the scattering of the Ten Lost Tribes of Yisrael with the end times events. The following study includes many scriptural verses that will point you to a time frame that is quickly approaching, The completion of a prophecy by Ezekiel that was set in motion about 800 BCE in conjunction with the Torah's Right Rulings and Instructions to Covenant Yisrael is the basis of this writing. Daniel told us that these mysteries of the "end times" will be revealed in these later days.

The Torah established guidelines for Yisrael who were in Covenant with YHWH. If Yisrael obeyed YHWH's Covenant then they were blessed. If Yisrael disobeyed YHWH's Covenant then they were cursed. Leviticus 26 lays out the pattern of **"Cursing's and Blessing's"**.

- **Lev 26:17** 'And I shall set My face against you, and you shall be smitten before your enemies. And those who hate you shall rule over you, and you shall flee when no one pursues you.
- Lev 26:33-34 'And I shall scatter you among the gentiles and draw out a sword after you. And your land shall be desert and your cities ruins, 34 and the land enjoy its Sabbaths as long as it lies waste and you are in your enemies' land. Then the land would rest and enjoy its Sabbaths.

According to Torah, if YHWH curses Yisrael for disobedience and Yisrael does not turn from this disobedience or accept His discipline, then YHWH will increase this curse seven times as seen in Lev 26:18-28:

- Lev 26:18 'And after all this, if you do not obey Me, then I shall punish you seven times more for your sins.
- Lev 26:21 'And if you walk contrary to Me, and refuse to obey Me, I shall bring on you seven times more plagues, according to your sins,
- Lev 26:24 then I also shall walk contrary to you, and I Myself shall smite you seven times for your sins.
- Lev 26:28 then I shall walk contrary to you in wrath. And I Myself shall punish you seven times for your sins.

Many years after Mosheh gave the written Torah at Mount Sinai, the prophet Ezekiel laid on his left side and prophesied that the Northern Kingdom would be exiled 390 years because of their "crookedness" (rebellion). Read Ezekiel 4 & 5 to see the extreme devastation that would come over Yisrael if they continued in their rebellion and did not turn back to Yahweh and repent. This curse that was placed on ancient Yisreal is all based upon rebellion to Yahweh's Word, His Torah.

Crookedness

Eze 5:6-7 'But she rebelled against My right rulings, doing wrong, more than the gentiles, and My laws more than the lands all around her. For they have rejected My right-rulings, and they have not walked in My laws.' 7 "Therefore thus said the Master המוד, 'Because you have rebelled more than the gentiles all around you, and have not walked in My laws, nor done My right-rulings, nor even done according to the right-rulings of the gentiles all around you,

As a result of this rebellion and turning their backs on his established Covenant, Yahweh said he would scatter them throughout the nations. This was first prophesied by Ya'aqob as he laid on his death bed in Egypt and prophesied to Yoseph and his two sons Manessah and Ephraim. This took place in approximately 1,744 BCE and was confirmed by Ezekiel approximately 1,150 years later.

390 years of Exile in Original Prophecy

Eze 4:4-5 "And lie on your left side, and you shall put the crookedness of the house of Yisra'ël on it. As many days as you lie on it, you shall bear their crookedness. 5 "For I Myself have laid on you <u>the years</u> of their crookedness, according to the number of the days, <u>three hundred and</u> <u>ninety (390) days</u>. And you shall bear the crookedness of the house of Yisra'ël.

Historical facts show that Yisrael (the Northern Kingdom) was exiled in five different fronts from 722 BCE to 714 BCE. Based on this, Yisrael's exile should have been completed by approximately 324 BCE. However, we know that it never happened. When Yahushua showed up on the scene, over 744 years had gone by since Yisrael's exile and he stated that His mission was to reach out to the "Lost Sheep of Yisrael". Through Yahushua's teaching, Yisrael was lost and still in exile.

Mat_10:6 but rather go to the. lost sheep of the house of Yisra'ĕl Mat_15:24 And He answering, said, "I was not sent except to the lost sheep of the house of Yisra'ĕl."

The additional Torah penalty found in Leviticus also went into effect. They had not repented of their crookedness nor accepted YHWH's discipline, so the curse was multiplied by seven. By now the Northern Kingdom was being dispersed throughout the nations and they were slowly melting in with the customs of these nations. They were losing their identity and getting farther from the Truth ("Torah"). The curse would now be multiplied by seven and come to an end at a much later date as follows:

End of Curse

Initial curse: Multiplication Factor: Total Curse: Start of curse: End of curse: 390 years
7x (additional discipline)
2,730 years (= 7 x 390)
722 BCE to 714 BCE
2,008 CE to 2,016 CE

Notice how this curse will be completed in the next two years (this is written in 2014). Have you ever wondered why we are seeing a large exodus back to Yisrael in these last few years? This is not a coincidence. The curse is coming to an end and YHWH is stirring the hearts of His people (Lost Sheep) to return to the land.

But now let us look at another prophecy that Daniel stated in Daniel 12: 1-13. In verses 1-3 Daniel is talking about a time of extreme distress, such as never was in the history of this world. He is talking about the 3 ¹/₂ year period in which the world would be "tipped upside down" and will proceed through a series of judgments that will shake the very core of every living thing on earth.

Dan 12:1-3 "Now at that time Mika'ěl shall stand up, the great head who is standing over the sons of your people. And there shall be a time of <u>distress, such as never was since there was a nation</u>, until that time. And at that time your people shall be delivered, every one who is found written in the book, 2 and many of those who sleep in the dust of the earth wake up, some to everlasting life, and some to reproaches, everlasting abhorrence. 3 "And those who have insight (follow Torah) shall shine like the brightness of the expanse, and those who lead many to righteousness like the stars forever and ever.

Then in verse 4, Daniel is talking about sealing the scroll until the time of the end.

Dan 12:4 "But you, Dani'ěl, <u>hide the words</u>, and <u>seal the book</u> until <u>the time of the end</u>¹. Many shall diligently search and knowledge shall increase."

Then a question was asked in verses 5 & 6: "How long until the end of these wonders?" The response was:

Dan 12:5-6 Then I, Dani'ěl, looked and saw two others standing, one on this bank of the river and the other on that bank. 6 And one said to the man dressed in linen, who was above the waters of the river, <u>"How long until the end of these wonders?"</u>

Now look very closely at the response and the time of these events.

Dan 12:7 And I heard the man dressed in linen, who was above the waters of the river, and he held up his right hand and his left hand to the heavens, and swore by Him who lives forever, that it would <u>be</u> for a time, times, and half a time (3 ½ years). And when they have <u>ended scattering the power of the</u> <u>set-apart people</u>, then all these shall be completed.

This time of extreme distress will last for a 3 ½ year period and has been described by many scholars as the "Great Tribulation Period". At the end of this period, Yahushua will come back and defeat the armies of the world, and then proceed into His millennial reign with His remnant. However, you will notice that there is a remnant that is brought through this time of extreme distress. That remnant is talked about in Revelation chapters 3,12, and 14, and is described as those who have Guarded the Covenant and His commands. It is His Faithful Bride who Believes in Yahushua and proves this Belief by walking in Obedience to His Torah.

Rev 3:8-10 "I know your works – see, I have set before you an open door, and no one is able to shut it – that you have little power, yet have **guarded My Word (Torah)**, and have **not denied My Name** (**Yahushua**). 9 "See, I am giving up those of the congregation of Satan, who say they are Yehudim and are not, but lie. See, I am making them come and worship before your feet, and to know that I have loved you. 10 "Because **you have guarded My Word (Torah)** of endurance, I also **shall guard you from the hour of trial** which shall come upon all the world, to try those who dwell on the earth.

Rev 12:17 And the dragon was enraged with the woman, and he went to fight with <u>the remnant</u> of her seed, those guarding the commands of Elohim (Torah) and possessing the <u>witness of איזשע Messiah.</u>

Rev 14:12 Here is the endurance of the set-apart ones, here are those <u>guarding the commands of</u> <u>Elohim</u> and the <u>belief of אוושע</u>

But notice in verse 7 that the <u>"end of scattering of the Set Apart people"</u> play into this equation as well. On page two, we see that the "Curse of Scattering" is completed in 2016. This is right around the corner. We are entering into a time that will try every human being on earth. Daniel is stating in His prophesy that this <u>"end of the scattering"</u> and this "<u>3 ½ year Tribulation Period"</u> are linked to a "common time line". We don't know exactly how this will play out, but it is probably telling us to be prepared for some major events that will be happening in the very near future. When you tie this to other witnesses including the blood moon tetrads in 2014 and 2015 (on the feast of Matzot and Sukkot), the solar eclipse in 2016 on the Feast of Trumpets, and the Yobel years, it gets your attention.

We are at the threshold of the seventh millennium in which Yahushua will begin His reign very shortly. The scattering of His lost sheep is coming to an end in just a few short years. Then He will gather His remnant as He has promised throughout the Scriptures. Yahweh is revealing the mysteries of the ages to those who are walking in Truth.

Dan 12:3 "And those <u>who have insight</u> shall shine like the brightness of the expanse, and those who lead many to righteousness like the stars forever and ever.

Dan 12:4 "But you, Dani'ěl, <u>hide the words</u>, and <u>seal the book</u> until <u>the time of the end</u>. Many shall diligently search and <u>knowledge shall increase</u>."

1Th 5:4 But you, brothers, <u>are not in darkness</u>, so that **this Day should overtake you as a thief**.

There is no time to waste. We must be in the Word like never before. The Torah needs to be the "Foundation" of our walk in Truth with no excuses or exceptions. As a Faithful Bride, we love Him and we truly love to walk in the marriage covenant that He has established for His children.

Additional background verses regarding Yahushua being the "Walking-Talking" Torah:

- **Isa 2:3** And many peoples shall come and say, "Come, and let us go up to the mountain of דהה, to the House of the Elohim of Yaʿaqoḇ, and let Him teach¹ us His ways¹, and let us walk in His paths¹, for out of Tsiyon comes forth the Torah (Yahushua)¹, and the <u>Word¹ of ההה</u> from Yerushalayim."
- Rev 19:13 and having been dressed in a robe dipped in blood <u>(Yahushua)</u>– and <u>His Name is called: The</u> <u>Word of איז</u>ה.
- Mat 7:23 "And then I shall declare to them, 'I never knew you, depart from Me, you who work lawlessness!' (Without Torah/ You reject Torah- You reject Yahushua)

Mat 5:17-18 "Do not think that I came to destroy the Torah or the Prophets.¹ I did not come to destroy but to complete. Footnote: ¹The Law and the Prophets is a term used for the pre-Messianic Scriptures. 18 "For truly, I say to you, till the heaven and the earth pass away, one jot or one tittle shall by no means **pass from the Torah** till all be done.¹ Footnote: 19 "Whoever, then, breaks one of the least of these commands, and teaches men so, shall be called least in the reign of the heavens; but whoever does and teaches them, he shall be called great in the reign of the heavens. 20 "For I say to you, that **unless your righteousness (Torah in your Heart)** exceeds that of the scribes and Pharisees,¹ you shall by no means enter into the reign of the heavens.

Notice that Heaven and Earth serve as a witness that the Torah is truth and is the everlasting Word of YHWH. So what is Righteousness? - It is Torah in your Heart!

- **Isa 51:7** "Listen to Me, **you who know righteousness**, a people in **whose heart is My Torah**: do not fear the reproach of men, nor be afraid of their revilings.
- Jer 31:33 "For this is the covenant I shall make with the house of Yisra'ël after those days, declares איזה: I shall <u>put My Torah in their inward parts</u>, and <u>write it on their hearts</u>. And I shall be their Elohim, and they shall be My people. Yahushua <u>circumcised our hearts with the Torah</u>. This was completed on the torture stake.

Psa 119:142 Your <u>righteousness is righteousness forever</u>, And **Your Torah is truth**. (and Righteousness is Torah in your Heart!)

Psa 119:151 You are near, O יהוה, And <u>all Your commands are truth</u>.

Joh 5:45-47 "Do not think that I shall accuse you to the Father. There is one who accuses you: Mosheh (Torah), in whom you have set your expectation. 46 "For if you believed Mosheh (Torah), you would have believed Me, since he wrote about Me. 47 "But if you do not believe his writings, <u>how shall you believe My words?</u>

Every man will be judged in the end according to the standards of Torah. The Torah requires us to observe the seventh day Shabbat, not Sunday. It requires us to observe the Feasts of YHWH, not the pagan holidays

of Christmas, Easter, New Years etc. We are to eat according to the Covenant requirements of His Torah. By doing so, we prove to Him that we Love Him and that our proclaimed Belief in Him is True.

- **1Jn 2:3-4** And by this we know that we know Him, if we guard His commands. 4 The one who says, "I know Him," and does not guard His commands, is a liar, and the truth is not in him.
- **1Jn 2:5-6** But whoever **guards His Word (Torah)**, truly the love of Elohim has been perfected¹ in him. By this we know that we are in Him. 6 The one who says he stays in Him ought himself **also to walk**, **even as He walked**.
